## **ATTENTION:** Trash Pick-Up Day Has Changed!

## <u>Beginning Wednesday, FEBRUARY 14, 2024,</u> the scheduled TRASH/RECYCLE PICK-UP DAY CHANGED TO <u>WEDNESDAYS.</u>

## \*\*\*Nothing else is changing other than the day for trash pick-up.\*\*\*

Please contact the SKHOA Property Manager, Nicole Kraten, at propertymanager@summitknollshoa.com or call the SKHOA Message Center at 585-935-5032 with any questions or concerns.

This change will enable Seyrek to continue to give us their best service.

- Please have your garbage out for collection on <u>Tuesday Nights</u>. The routes run from **6:30 AM to 5:00 PM each day**. Those SKHOA residences with driveways, please place your trash/recycle items near the end of your driveway but not into the street.

- If your trash/recycle is not collected by 5:30 PM on Wednesday, please contact the SKHOA Property Manager, Nicole Kraten, at propertymanager@summitknollshoa.com or through the Message Center at 585-935-5032. Please be sure your trash is secured within trash bags or containers. Do not pile loose materials around the bags or cans for pickup.

- Up to <u>FIVE (5)</u> standard size and weight garbage bags in addition to the garbage TOTE will be allowed for pickup weekly. Any more than 5 bags (counting both garbage and yard debris) will be charged at \$5.00 per bag. <u>PLEASE NOTE: ADDITIONAL CHARGES ARE NOT COVERED BY THE SKHOA</u> <u>MONTHLY ASSESSMENT FEE AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE HOMEOWNER OF RECORD.</u>

- Your Tash Cans, Totes, and Recycle Bins should be returned to your garage or backyard patio area by Wednesday evening. If you are away, please make arrangements for these items to be stored for you after pickup.

- HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY is permitted so if you are remodeling a home, we DO NOT pick up wood, windows, doors and other building materials. If these materials are put out with the household trash for collection, they will not be picked up and must be stored and disposed of by the Homeowner.

- In general, 1 garbage TOTE and up to 5 <u>household</u> trash bags are acceptable. REMEMBER to paint/label your <u>house number and street name</u> on your totes/cans/recycle bins in case they become wind-blown or misplaced and need to be returned to the proper address.
- Up to 2 RECYCLABLE bins are acceptable. Additional recyclables in a bag <u>need to be labeled</u> as recyclables and should be within the 5-bag total limit.

- ELECTRONICS must be recycled with a provider of your choice such as ECOPARK <u>https://monroecounty.gov/ecopark/</u>. Seyrek does not accept electronics.
- Carpeting and padding should be cut into 2-4 foot-lengths; rolled and tied into bundles that one person can lift.
- For any items other than household trash, you will need to check with the SKHOA Property Manager at <u>propertymanager@summitknollshoa.com</u> or call the Message Center at 585-935-5032 to determine next steps.
- No oil, batteries, car parts or antifreeze of any kind.
- Hazardous waste will not be taken.

- Notifications of Holiday Schedule changes will be published in the <u>SKHOA Newsletter</u> and will be available on our website homepage at <u>www.summitknollshoa.com</u>. Homeowners who are members on the SKHOA website will also receive an email notification of these changes as they occur. SKHOA Homeowners may go to our website for information on how to become a member.

You may also visit the Seyrek website <u>www.seyrekdisposal.com</u> and view the calendar for Holiday pickups. If a holiday falls between Monday through Friday, the <u>default pick-up day will be Thursday</u>.
